

DNR LAKE DESIGNATIONS - SUMMER/WINTER FISHING

<p><u>Class I</u> <u>Lakes that have a public access, shared lakeshore ownership.</u> There are no motor restrictions on these lakes, and overnight fish houses are permitted. Access to the lake through park boat launches is permitted until 10 PM. Egress from the lake through park boat launches is permitted twenty-four hours/day. At locations where there is no entry gate, access and exit are twenty-four hours/day.</p>	<p><u>Class II</u> <u>Lakes that have a public access, but are totally within the Park District.</u> No gas motors (including vehicles of any type) are permitted on these lakes, except gas augers for ice fishing. Electric trolling motors only. Overnight fish houses are not permitted. Access and egress is limited to 5 AM– 10 PM</p>	<p><u>Class III</u> <u>Non-fishing lakes that have no public access, and are totally within the Park District.</u> There is no access or recreational activity supported on these lakes.</p>

Baker Park Reserve – Maple Plain

- **Lake Independence (Class I)** (844 acres) Concrete access, parking for 58 trailers, located off main park road, 1/4 mile south of intersection of County Road 19 and County Road 24. Trailer parking fills up early on weekends and holidays. Additional non-motorized boat access located south of creative play area, near reservation picnic area. Muskies, Walleye, Northern Pike and Crappies.
- **Spurzem Lake (Class I)** (70 acres) Concrete access, parking for 6 trailers, located one mile east of County Road 19 on County Road 201. Northern Pike and Crappies.
- **Half Moon Lake (Class II)** (28 acres) Carry-in access located off County Road 19 at Half Moon Group Camp; carry boat a few hundred yards. Northern Pike, Sunfish and Bullheads.
- **Katrina (Class III)** No access or recreational activity.

Bryant Lake Regional Park – Eden Prairie

- **Bryant Lake (Class I)** (177 acres) Concrete access, parking for 20 trailers, located off main park road. 15-mph speed limit on Sundays; Memorial Day through Labor Day from noon to 6:00 p.m. Northern Pike, Muskies, Sunfish and Crappies.

Carver Park Reserve - Victoria

- **Crosby Lake, Lake II Lake, Sunny Lake, Lundsten Lake (Class III)** No access or recreational activity.
- **Lake Zumbra (Class I)** (162 acres) Non-paved (gravel) access, parking for 12 trailers, located on Park Drive. *No boat/trailer fee.* Large Mouth Bass, Northern Pike, Sunfish and Crappies.
- **Lake Auburn (Class I)** (284 acres) Non-paved access, parking for 12 trailers, located off Carver Park Road. Northern Pike, Largemouth Bass, Sunfish, Crappies and Bullheads. No boat/trailer fee at this lake. *Operated by the DNR.*
- **Stieger Lake (Class I)** (158 acres) Non-paved (gravel) access, parking for 12 trailers, located on Stieger Lake Lane. 15-mph speed limit. Walleye, Sunfish, Crappies. Bass and Northern Pike must be released if caught.
- **Stone Lake (Class II)** No public access. Usage from lakeshore residences is very limited.
- **Parley Lake (Class I)** (242 acres) *Concrete access located on Parley Lake Lane; north of Highway 5.* Northern Pike, Large mouth Bass, Crappies and Bullheads. *Operated by the DNR.*

Cleary Lake Regional Park – Prior Lake

- **Cleary Lake (Class II)** (143 acres) Non-paved (earthen) access located near Oak Grove Group Camp. Largemouth Bass, Walleye and Sunfish.

Crow Hassan Park Reserve – Hanover

- **Prairie Lake (Class III)** No access or recreational activity.

Eagle Lake Regional Park - Plymouth

- **Eagle Lake (Class I)** (291 acres) Fishing pier. Muskies, Northern Pike, Walleye, Bass, Crappies and Sunfish. *Small boat access at northeast corner of the lake. Operated by the DNR.*
- **Pike Lake (Class I)** Access through narrow channel from Eagle Lake (small boat).

Elm Creek Park Reserve – Maple Grove

- **Goose Lake (Class III)** No public access. Usage from lakeshore residences is very limited.
- **Hayden Lake, Lemans Lake, Powers Lake, Mud Lake (Class III)** No access or recreational activity.

Fish Lake Regional Park - Maple Grove

- **Fish Lake (Class I)** (223 acres) Concrete access, parking for 12 trailers. Restrictions on direction of boat travel and speed limits (Maple Grove regulations). Northern Pike, Largemouth Bass and Sunfish.

French Regional Park – Plymouth

- **Medicine Lake (Class I)** (886 acres) Concrete access, parking for 52 trailers, 3 spaces for car-top units (canoes, kayaks), located off main park road. Shallow launch area. Largemouth Bass, Northern Pike, Crappies and Sunfish.

Gale Woods Farm – Minnetrista

- **Whaletail Lake (Class I)** (558 acres) Carry-in canoe access ½ mile from main parking lot. Largemouth Bass, Northern Pike, Crappies and Sunfish. *Concrete access located on south shore of the NW basin. Operated by the DNR.*

Hyland Lake Park Reserve - Bloomington

- **Anderson Lake (Class II)** No public access. Usage from private residences is very limited.
- **Hyland Lake (Class II)** (84 acres) Concrete access, located off East Bush Lake Road near the Visitor Center. Large Mouth Bass, Sunfish and Muskies. Note: Largemouth-Black Bass in possession must be less than 12" or greater than 16" in length.

Lake Minnetonka Regional Park - Minnetrista

- **Lake Minnetonka (Class I)** (14,004 acres) Concrete access, parking for 55 trailers. Parking area is up hill from boat launch. Northern Pike, Walleye, Muskies, Sunfish and Black Crappies.

Lake Rebecca Park Reserve – Rockford

- **Lake Rebecca (Class II)** (290 acres) Concrete access, parking for 28 trailers. Largemouth Bass, Muskies, Walleye, Crappies and Sunfish. Note: Largemouth Black Bass in possession must be less than 12" or greater than 16" in length. Minimum size limit for Muskies on Lake Rebecca is 48 inches.
- **Rattail Lake (Class III)** No access or recreational activity.

Lake Sarah Regional Park – Greenfield

- **Lake Sarah (Class I)** (574 acres) Northern Pike, Crappies and Sunfish. *Concrete access located on the southwest shore of the west basin. Operated by the city of Greenfield.*

Murphy-Hanrehan Park Reserve - Savage

- **Hanrehan Lake (Class II)** No public access. Usage from private residences is very limited.
- **Minnregs Lake (Class III)** No access or recreational activity.
- **Murphy Lake (Class II)** (70 acres) Concrete access, parking for 5 trailers, located off Murphy Lake Blvd. Shallow lake. Crappies, Bass and Sunfish.

Silverwood – St. Anthony

Silver Lake (Class I) (70 acres) Fishing pier. Canoe launch. Northern Pike, Walleye, Bullheads and Crappies. *Boat access operated by the City of Columbia Heights is located on the southwest side of the lake.*
