Children (8-17 years old) can request a scholarship to participate in The First Tee of Three Rivers Park District. Scholarships are available for children from those groups identified by National Golf Foundation research as underrepresented in golf. They are juniors with financial need, girls, minority youth and children with disabilities. **To be considered for a scholarship juniors must be from one of the four underrepresented groups.**
