### **Program Assistant Opportunities**

#### Free Family Fun Day: Puppet Art Adventures

Sunday, April 14 Sunday, May 12 12:30PM-3:00PM

**Art Assistants (2-6 volunteers).** Assist families and children with making art and learning about nature after a puppet show. This program is best for folks who enjoy enthusiastically explaining instructions and are comfortable standing for most of the program.

#### **Clothing Swap**

Sunday, April 21 12:30-3:30PM

**Event Assistants (2 volunteers).** Directing participants in sorting their donated clothing items by category. Supporting event staff in packing any unclaimed items at the end of the swap for donation to local charity.

#### International Sculpture Day

Saturday, April 27 1PM-4PM

**Art Assistants (2-6 volunteers).** Assist youth and families with making art related to the sculptures along the trail. This program is best for folks who enjoy enthusiastically explaining instructions and are comfortable standing for most of the program. Be prepared to be outdoors if the weather allows.

#### Older Adult Open House

Wednesday, May 29 9:30AM-12:30PM

**Art Assistants (2-6 volunteers).** Support artmaking activities with seniors during a drop-in, sampler event aimed at introducing new individuals or groups from residential communities to the opportunities for older adults in the park.

## **Volunteer Docents**

Docents work in small groups or on their own to encourage park guests to engage with the art in the gallery or along the trails, relating the work to environmental themes. Docents receive training from Silverwood staff then sign up for shifts to be present in the gallery, ideally during busy weekend times (for example, 1-3PM on Saturdays or Sundays).
