

Volunteer Fun Passes (VFP) are issued annually to ongoing, active volunteers based on hours of volunteer service in a 12-month period (Oct. 1-Sep. 30). There are several privilege levels based on service hours:

- Less than 15 hours (10-point punch card)
- 15 hours or more (20-point punch card)
- 30 hours or more (20-point punch card and a choice of one Activity Pass)
- Active volunteers reaching or exceeding life total hour milestones of 500 or 1000 hours will also receive silver or gold level privileges, including privileges for qualifying family members.

### Punch Card (10-point or 20-point)

The punch card must be presented at a staffed facility and punched for the number of points used (to use at remote locations with drop boxes, request a Drop Box Day Pass Waiver from your supervisor or nearest staffed facility). The punch card is non-transferable; however, the card holder may use this card to bring a guest. The card is non-replaceable if lost.

### Activity Pass:

Annual activity passes are valid Jan. 1-Dec. 31. Season pass dates are indicated below. Passes are non-transferable. Additional passes may be purchased for household members. [www.threeriversparks.org/activities/passes.aspx](http://www.threeriversparks.org/activities/passes.aspx)

- Archery Pass – (Elm Creek Jan. 1-Dec. 31; Carver Apr. 1-Nov 15)  
*A pass is required for each archer. Youth 15 years and younger are free but must be accompanied by an adult pass holder.*
- Boat Trailer Pass (Apr. 1-Nov. 30)  
*A pass is required to park boat trailers.*
- Cross-country Ski Pass (Three Rivers) (Winter ski season as trail conditions allow)  
*A pass is required for all skiers 12 years of age and older.*
- Disc Golf Pass (Note: Elm Creek & Hyland close Oct. 1; Bryant close Oct. 31 or as course conditions allow)  
*A pass is required for all disc golfers.*
- Dog Off-leash Area Pass  
*The annual pass is valid for members of the same household.*
- Horse Riding Pass  
*A pass is required for all riders 12 and older.*
- Swim Pond Pass (Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day)  
*To be determined if pass will be a family or individual pass.*

## Silver Level Volunteer Fun Pass:

The silver level VFP offers additional privileges and is earned by volunteers with 500 or more life total hours.

Eligible volunteers will receive a silver level VFP coupon. A laminated wallet card is issued to each eligible volunteer and qualifying family members<sup>1</sup> as requested and must be presented as specified on the card and below to receive authorized privileges.

  - \$6 discount on championship course 18 holes, \$3 discount on championship 9 holes, \$2 discount on executive course green fees
  - Senior rate (ages 62+) Mon.-Thu., excluding leagues and holidays; 18 holes and half cart for \$39
  - Small range ball with paid round on Championship Course
  - Discounted Range Punch Card
  - 14-day advanced reservations on the executive courses

## Gold Level Volunteer Fun Pass:

The gold level VFP offers additional privileges and is earned by volunteers with 1000 or more hours of service.

Eligible volunteers will receive a gold level VFP request form. A laminated wallet card is issued to each eligible volunteer and qualifying family members<sup>1</sup> as requested and must be presented as specified on the card and below to receive authorized privileges.

<sup>1</sup> **Qualifying family members** are defined as a **spouse** or **significant other** living in the same household, as well as **children** who are claimed as a dependent on the eligible volunteer's federal income tax return.
