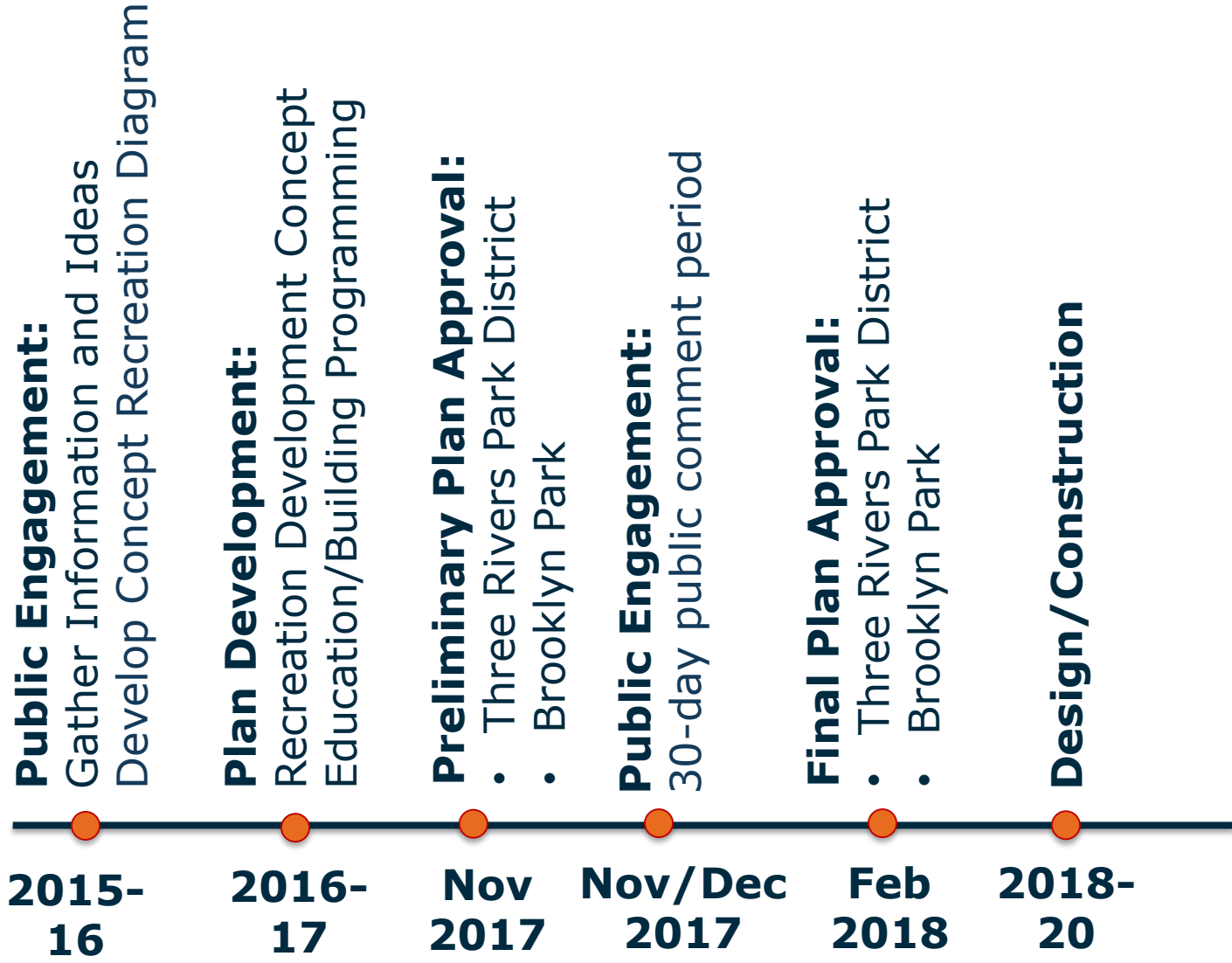

Goals:

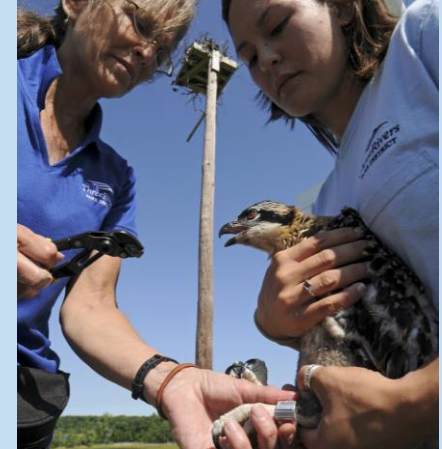
- Celebrate the Mississippi River as the heart of the park
